

How the Integration Works

Behind the scenes, the process is seamless.

- Users design in Canva as usual, select "publish to Signage+," and the content appears in the Signage+ dashboard for scheduling and distribution.
- 2. From there, displays are selected to target the content and specify when and where it should appear.
- 3. Because Signage+ supports multi-zone layouts, content can appear alongside other media, widgets, or live updates, ensuring every display feels active and relevant.
- 4. Real-time publishing ensures changes can be made instantly when timing matters most, such as weather alerts or last-minute event updates.

The result is a communication system that feels alive, reflecting what's happening on campus right now.
